a) "General Housing" - beds for inmates not designated/requiring "special" supervision and/or services;
b) "Special Management" - beds for inmates designated/requiring "special" supervision such as crisis intervention; deathrow; hospital; maximum custody; mental health; protective custody; pre-hearing detention; security detention; safekeeper; and temporary holding (transient); and

c) "Programs" - beds for inmates in specific locations for program participation such as assisted living; addictions treatment; Educational Finance Act eligible inmates; habilitation; handicap; Youthful Offender Act programs; reception/evaluation; shock incarceration; transitional care; HIV therapeutic; and sex offender treatment.
